

Changes to Bank of China (Australia) Internet Banking and Mobile Banking Terms and Conditions (Effective as at 10 July 2023)

The following changes to Internet Banking and Mobile Banking Terms and Conditions have been applied to reflect new features available on Internet Banking and Mobile Banking.

1 Registration for Mobile Banking service through the Mobile Banking app

If the Bank holds a copy of your current Passport, Driver Licence or Proof of Age Card document (i.e. the document expiry date is a future date) as your Identification Document you can use the Mobile Banking app to register for the service.

- 1.1 Select Register Now from the top right hand corner of the login screen and follow the prompts to register.

2 Set SMS transaction notification

You can use Internet and Mobile Banking to set SMS notifications for transactions to or from an Account linked to Your Debit Card to your registered mobile phone number. For Accounts not linked to a Debit Car you can set up SMS transaction notification at your local Branch.

- 2.1 Select the SMS Service menu option after selecting the Debit Card Service menu option and follow the prompts.

3 Set your Term Deposit Maturity Instructions

When setting up a Term Deposit Account you may set your maturity instructions by selecting from the options:

- (i) Rollover principal and interest.
- (ii) Rollover principal and withdraw interest.
- (iii) Withdraw principal and interest.
